Travel	<p>By air: From Vienna Airport (Schwechat) you can take the S-Bahn (commuter train) or the CAT (City Airport Train) to Wien Mitte (which is, in spite of the name not the central station). There you take the subway line 4 (green), towards "Heiligenstadt" and get off at "Friedensbrücke", where you change to tram 5 or 33 going west and exit at station "Spitalgasse". From there it is a few minutes to walk (go south).</p> <p>Alternatively you can get off the subway 4 already at "Schottenring" and change to subway 2 (purple line) towards "Karlsplatz" and get off at station "Schottentor", from where it is also a few minutes to walk (this time to the north), or, if you are lazy or your luggage is heavy, you can take tram 38 towards "Grinzing" and exit at the first stop "Schwarzspanierstraße" from where it is an even shorter walk.</p> <p>By train: From Wien Hauptbahnhof (which is the main station) you would take subway 1 (red line) towards "Leopoldau", and at "Karlsplatz" change to line 2 (purple) towards "Aspernstadt" and get off at "Schottentor". Then see above.</p> <p>From Wien Westbahnhof take subway 3 (orange line) towards "Simmering", and at "Volkstheater" change to line 2 (purple) towards "Aspernstraße", get off at "Schottentor" and see above.</p> <p>Tickets: The CAT ticket is only good for the CAT. Anything else uses the same tickets. From the airport via commuter train etc. you need two zones altogether, from Wien Mitte only one.</p> <p>And if you want to know more, check http://www.anachb.at/bin/query.exe/en?L=vs_anachb&</p>
